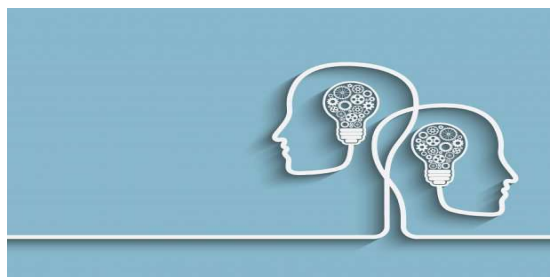

Last date of submission of full paper: 30 June 2017

Registration: After getting acceptance of abstract, the paper presenter is required to intimate following particulars by E-mail: 1.Name of the paper presenter, 2. Title of the paper, 3. Whether paper presentation will be through Power point? (If yes, the paper has to be sent earlier by e-mail), 4.Date of arrival at Agartala (In case of out station participants), 5. Whether the paper presenter needs assistance for hostel accommodation?.

PUBLICATION OF PROCEEDINGS:

Papers presented at the conference shall be reviewed and if required, paper presenters shall be asked by 16th July to correct the paper and resend by 31st July. Suitable papers shall be included in the Conference publication having ISBN. Paper presenters shall have to bear the cost.
