The visit ended with an assurance of the students to remain connected with Apnaghar and the people residing there.



"An Institutional workshop on Self Defense Techniques"
On the eve of Swami Vivekananda Jayanti / National Youth Day

INTRODUCTION

Self-defense has been a familiar concept to everyone since childhood. We are all acutely aware of the current state of Indian society and the worsening condition of Indian women within it. The sense of unease is as strong as the danger-filled environment. Assailants, whose cruelty knows no bounds, pose a threat to individuals of all ages, from young toddlers to older men and women. It is essential for everyone to learn self-defense skills to protect themselves and fight for their lives without relying on weapons. It is our collective responsibility to become our own best protectors. As the saying goes, "Self-defense is not only our right, it is our duty." – Ronald Reagan.

With this purpose, our Department Faculty of Liberal Arts had organized a workshop on Self Defense Techniques. Students from different departments participate in this workshop.

INAUGURAL SESSION

The workshop started with an inaugural speech by Mr. Uttam Acharjee (Self Defense Expert). He highlighted the key points why such kinds of workshops are required to sensitize our girl child/students to self-protect themselves in public places as well as at home. He also pointed out that this is the demand of the hour as we can relate ourselves to the news items of domestic violence, eve-teasing cases and other severe forms of violence against women and children which is pouring in on a day to day basis. He pointed out why it is necessary to attend and train oneself with this kind of workshop and training programmers. He said that having knowledge about self defense techniques not only helps defend but also it builds confidence in oneself. Mr. Uttam Acharjee demonstrates the different techniques Mr. Deepjoy Das, Ranajit Singha. Johan Tripura, Ms. Hantela Kasleya Tripura, Soni Datta. Rajashree Debnath. Kabita Kalai help him also to communicate with students.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM

- Assertiveness and Boundary Setting: Empower students to assertively communicate their boundaries and say no to unwanted advances or threats. Provide techniques for assertive verbal communication and protection strategies to defuse potentially volatile situations.
- Physical Techniques for Self-Defense: Teach students practical self-defense techniques
 that are effective in real-life situations, focusing on simple yet powerful moves that target
 vulnerable areas of the attacker's body. Techniques should include strikes, blocks, escapes
 from grabs, and ground defense.
- Confidence Building: Build students' confidence in their ability to defend themselves by providing opportunities for practice and simulated scenarios. Encourage them to trust their instincts and make quick decisions under pressure.
- Legal and Ethical Considerations: Educate students about the legal and ethical aspects of self-defense, including the concept of proportionality in using force, understanding the laws regarding self-defense in their jurisdiction, and the potential consequences of their actions. Emphasize the importance of using self-defense techniques responsibly and as a last resort.

By addressing these objectives, a self-defense workshop for university students can empower them with the skills and knowledge needed to stay safe and confident in various situations they may encounter both on and off campus.

OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAM

- Enhanced Situational Awareness: Students will develop a heightened awareness of their surroundings and the ability to recognize and avoid potential threats before they escalate. This includes understanding body language cues, assessing environmental risks, and recognizing the signs of potential danger.
- Empowerment and Empathy: Through self-defense training, students will develop a sense of empowerment and autonomy over their own safety. 




The feedback forms were distributed on 15th April, 2023 and collected on 15th April, 2023.

> INTRODUCTION ABOUT BLOOD DONATION:

Voluntary blood donors are the cornerstone of a safe and adequate supply of blood and blood products. The safest blood donors are voluntary, non-remunerated blood donors from low-risk populations. Despite this notion, family/replacement donors still provide more than 45% of the blood collected in India. Such donors are supposed to be associated with a significantly higher prevalence of transfusion-transmissible infections (TTIs) including HIV, hepatitis B, hepatitis C, syphilis and malaria.

For a safe blood service in our country, where comprehensive laboratory tests are neither possible nor pragmatic, it is best to switch over to 100% voluntary donations, as it is now established that only voluntary non-remunerated regular donation is the safest. Thus, one of our key strategies to enhance blood safety is to focus on motivating non-remunerated blood donors and phasing out even replacement donors. The key to recruiting and retaining safe blood donors is good epidemiological data on the prevalence (and incidence, where possible) of infectious markers in the general population to identify low-risk donor populations coupled with an effective donor education, motivation and recruitment strategy to recruit new voluntary non-remunerated blood donors from these populations. A pleasant environment in the blood bank, good donor care, polite and effective communication between staff and donors are all important factors for the retention of blood donors.

> OBJECTIVE OF BLOOD DONATION:

Voluntary blood donation is perhaps one of the most perfect examples of altruism in action.

- Ensure safety and quality of blood.
- Motivate and maintain a permanent well-indexed record of voluntary blood donors.
- Educating the community on the beneficial aspects of blood donation and harmful effect of collecting blood from paid donors.
- Actively encourage voluntary blood donation and gradually eliminate professional blood donors.

> ELIGIBILITY TO BLOOD DONATION:

Any healthy adult, both male and female, can donate blood. Men can donate safely once in every three months while women can donate every four months. The universally accepted criteria for donor selection are:

- Age between 18 and 60 years
- Haemoglobin not less than 12.5 g/dL
- Pulse between 50 and 100/minute with no irregularities
- Blood Pressure -Systolic 100-180 mm Hg and Diastolic 50 100 mm Hg Temperature
 Normal (oral temperature not exceeding 37.50 C)
- Body weight not less than 45 Kg




Image I: Promotional Banner for State level Skill Competition 2024 in Health and Social Care Trade.


