



Introduction:

Srinivasa Ramanujan was born on 22nd December 1887. In order to recognize his immense contribution towards Mathematics, the Government of India has decided to celebrate Ramanujan's birthday every year as National Mathematics Day.

Mathematics is more than dry text books and exercise and proofs, it is a world of great excitement and joy. To popularize the significance, importance and contribution of India towards mathematics, the Department of Mathematics of ICFAI University, Tripura has proposed to celebrate Mathematics Day from 8th January, 2024 to 10th January, 2024.

Objective:

The major goals of 'National Mathematics Day' celebration with expected benefits for students, for teachers, for women and girls and for society at large are to:

- 1. Improve understanding among the general public, decision makers and in schools, of the importance of mathematics in education.
- 2. Contribute to capacity building in mathematical and scientific education, with special focus on girls and children from developing countries.

- Raise awareness of the role of mathematics in fighting disasters, epidemics, emerging diseases, invasive species,
- 7. Highlight the role of mathematics in moving to a circular economy of sustainability compatible with preservation of biodiversity.
- 8. Increse international networking and collaboration public awareness of mathematics.
- 9. Increase the access to information, providing a simple way to give citizens a choice in all aspects of their daily life.

Description:

The Inaugural session of National Mathematics Day celebration is hosted by Rahul Roy and Monalisa Debbarma, B.Sc. (Mathematics) students of our institute. The session was started by welcoming the chief guest Dr. Shyamal Debnath, Professor, Department of Mathematics, Tripura University Tripura. Prof. P. R. Borthakur, Dean, FST felicitated the chief guest of the day by offering flower bouquet and a humble gift as a token of our respect and warmth.

Next lighting the lamp ceremony took place symbolizing seeding knowledge in one's mind. Chief guest Dr. Shyamal Debnath, Prof. (Dr.) Biplab Halder, Prof. (Dr.) P. R. Borthakur, Dean, FST, took part in this sacred ceremony. Student of Mathematics Department presented the inaugural song. A group song has been presented by our B.Sc. mathematics 1st year student Debalika Ghosh and 3rd year students Arkadeep Debnath and Isha Debnath. A classical Dance has been presented by our B.Sc. mathematics 3rd year student Joyashree Bhowmik. Dr. P. Bal delivered the vote of thanks afterwards. Near about 60 students from ICFAI University and other institutes, were present in the session.


Report Of Event Organized

To popularize mathematics, we have arranged a Mathematical Quiz competition for the under graduate students. On spot registration was done by Dr. A. Ghosh and Dr. D. Rakshit. Teams of two students from Tripura University, M.B.B. College, Ramthakur College, Women's College and ICFAI University, Tripura has participated in the competition. The quiz masters were Dr. Palash Mondal and Dr. Nilay Mondal. The quiz was designed in 5 different steps. In between the steps, there was an open quiz for the audience. 


Fig. 1: ICFAI University Tripura is proud to host its 19th Convocation on 21st September, 2024.




Fig. 1: Prof. (Dr.) Biplab Halder, VC, The ICFAI University, Tripura delivering speech during inauguration of Fresher's Welcome programme named as "Novatos-2K24" held on 24.09.2024.




Fig. 4: Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Govt. of Tripura delivering speech during inauguration of Fresher's Welcome programme named as "Novatos-2K24" held on 24.09.2024.




Fig. 5: A glimse during inauguration of Fresher's Welcome programme named as "Novatos-2K24" held on 24.09.2024.
