The presence of problem behavior in children gives strain on teachers, parents and others concerned. Besides, they may interfere with activities in the home /classroom settings. These problem behaviors could be due to a number of reasons like deficits in adaptive behavioral skills, cognitive skills or problem solving skills etc. So, in the same manner, high intensity and long duration of the above identified category of the behavior falls into the problem behaviors which may require modifications in classroom and at home.
