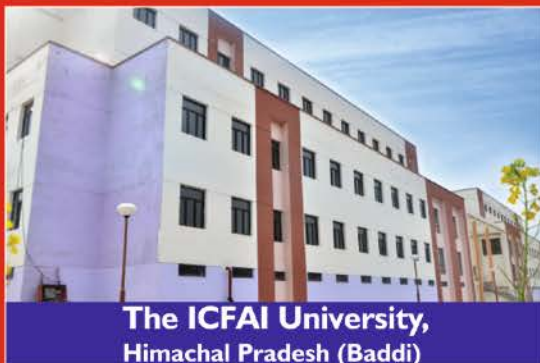

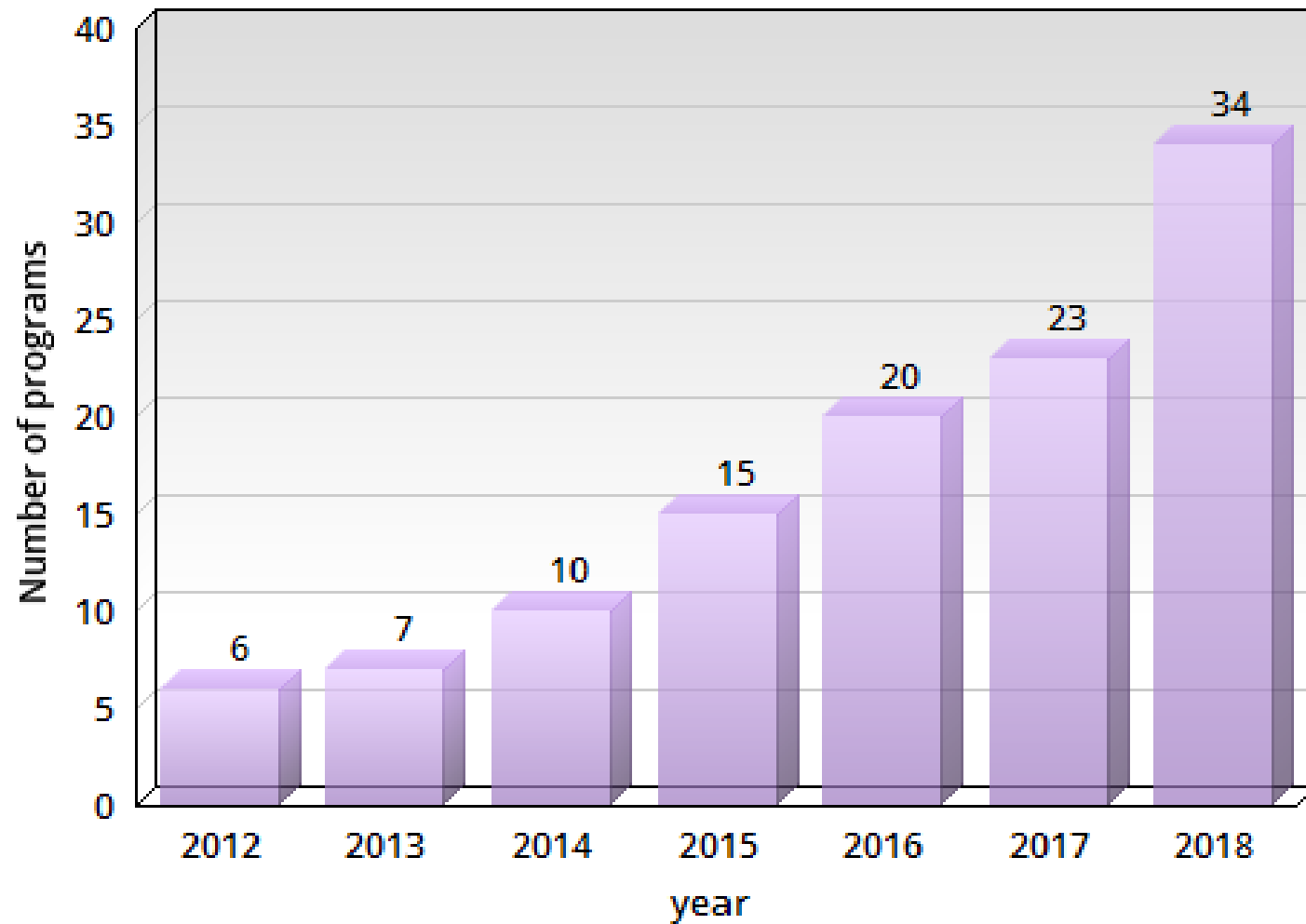

Year wise

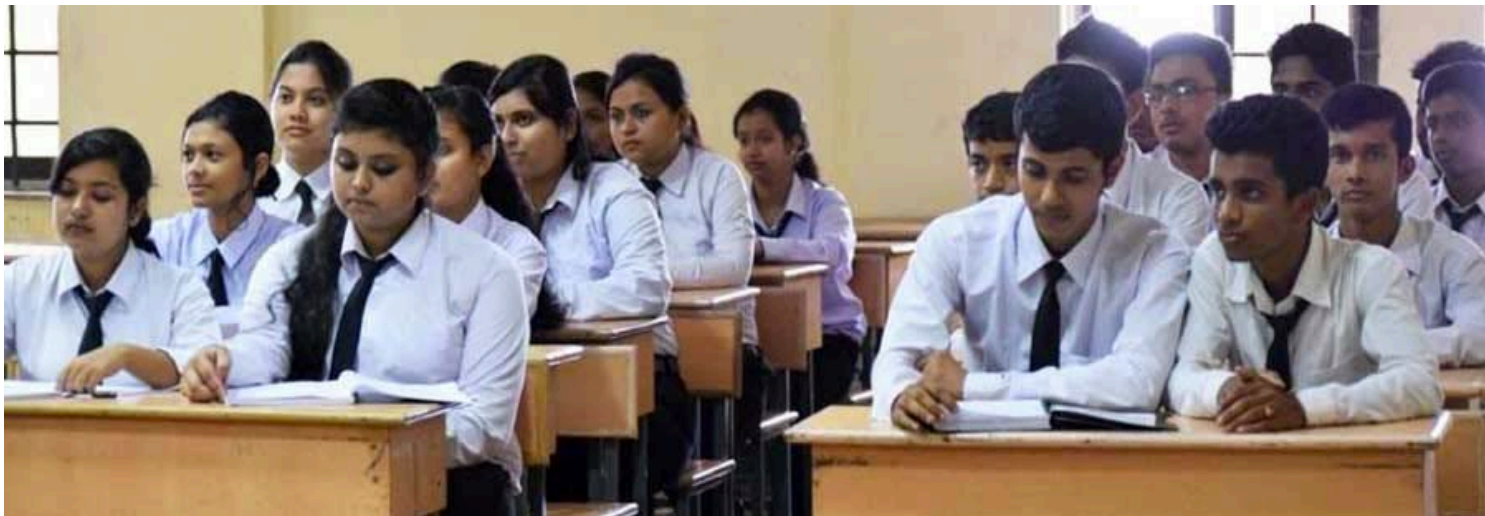
