ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

BACKGROUND OF THE SESSION

The Awareness Programme on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) was organized with the objective of sensitizing students, researchers, and faculty members about the significance of Intellectual Property in the present era of knowledge-driven economies. In today's competitive academic and industrial environment, intellectual creations such as inventions, designs, literary and artistic works, and innovative research outputs serve as valuable assets requiring protection under IPR laws. Recognizing the growing importance of intellectual property in promoting innovation, safeguarding the rights of creators, and fostering research and entrepreneurship, the programme was designed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of various dimensions of IPR.

The event was jointly organized by the IQAC Cell and IPR Cell in collaboration with the Research and Development Department, ICFAI University Tripura (IUT), conducted in hybrid mode on 12th August 2025 at the Ground Floor Auditorium, the session aimed to create awareness about the legal frameworks, procedures, and benefits associated with different forms of intellectual property.

The Organizing Committee of the session comprised Miss Anindita Saha, Research Scholar, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura, and Miss Madhurika De, Research Scholar, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University Tripura.

Through expert lectures and interactive discussions, the session sought to highlight the role of IPR in academic research, innovation, and entrepreneurship. The programme brought together eminent speakers from the Faculty of Law, IUT, who shared their expertise on Patent and Design Law as well as Copyright Law, thereby equipping the participants with practical insights and academic perspectives on protecting intellectual creations.

The initiative reflects the commitment of ICFAI University, Tripura towards nurturing a culture of research, innovation, and academic excellence, while also ensuring that students and faculty remain informed about the mechanisms available to protect their intellectual contributions.

REGISTRATION DETAIL

For the smooth conduct of the programme, an online Google Form was created to facilitate participant registration. The registration form was designed to capture essential information such as the name, designation, university/institutional affiliation, and preferred mode of attending (offline or online).

At the same time, a section of participants mentioned having no specific queries, indicating general curiosity and openness to learning from the session.

This innovative approach not only streamlined the participation process but also helped in making the session more interactive and need-based, as the speakers could align their discussions with the expectations of the attendees.

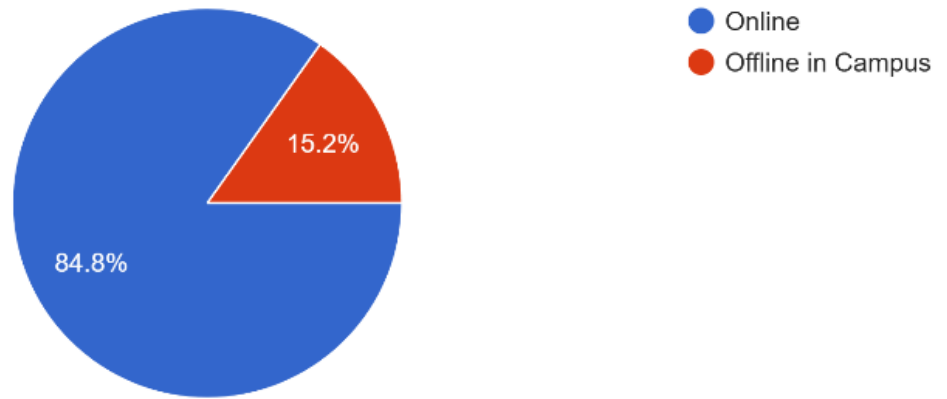

DETAIL REPORT OF THE SESSION

The Awareness Programme on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) was conducted in a structured manner, following the scheduled programme. Each segment of the event contributed to making the session insightful and engaging for the participants.

1. WELCOMING OF THE DIGNITARIES

The session commenced with a warm welcome by Miss Anindita Saha, Research Scholar, Faculty of Law, ICFAI University, Tripura, who served as the host of the programme. She extended greetings to the dignitaries, speakers, and participants, thereby setting the tone for the event and emphasizing its objective of raising awareness on Intellectual Property Rights.

2. INTRODUCTORY ADDRESS

Prof. (Dr.) Dhananjay Datta, Dean, Research and Development, ICFAI University Tripura, delivered the introductory address. In his remarks, he emphasized the importance of Intellectual Property Rights in today's knowledge-based society. He underlined how IPR protection not only safeguards the interests of innovators and researchers but also encourages creativity, entrepreneurship, and academic excellence. His address also highlighted the role of ICFAI University in promoting research, innovation, and legal awareness through such initiatives. Sir, also served as the moderator of the event, ensuring the smooth conduct of the sessions and interactive discussion.

3. LECTURE SESSION I BY DR. DEBABRATA ROY

The first technical session was conducted by Dr. Debabrata Roy, Associate Professor of Law, Faculty of Law, IUT, who focused on Patent Law. He explained the fundamentals of patents, including the process of obtaining a patent, the criteria of novelty, utility, and inventive step, as well as the rights conferred upon patent holders. Sir also elaborated on the practical relevance of patents in fostering technological advancement and protecting innovative ideas. His lecture was enriched with examples that made the concept of patents easily understandable for students and researchers.

4. LECTURE SESSION II BY DR. DIVYA PRAKASH PATHAK

The second technical session was delivered by Dr. Divya Prakash Pathak, Assistant Professor of Law, Faculty of Law, IUT. He spoke on Copyright Law and Design Law, emphasizing their importance in safeguarding artistic, literary, and creative works, as well as industrial designs.

He discussed the scope of copyright in protecting academic works, digital content, and cultural expressions, while also highlighting the commercial significance of design protection. His lecture provided participants with a comprehensive view of how copyright and design laws support both the academic community and industry innovators.

5. INTERACTIVE SESSION



Following the lectures, an interactive session was moderated by Prof. (Dr.) Dhananjoy Datta. Participants from both offline and online modes engaged actively, raising queries and sharing their perspectives on different aspects of IPR. The questions reflected curiosity about the procedural aspects of IPR protection, practical challenges in filing applications, and the role of intellectual property in academic research and innovation. The hybrid interaction ensured inclusivity, allowing all attendees—whether present in the auditorium or joining virtually—to contribute meaningfully. This dialogue helped bridge theoretical concepts with practical applications and enriched the overall learning experience.

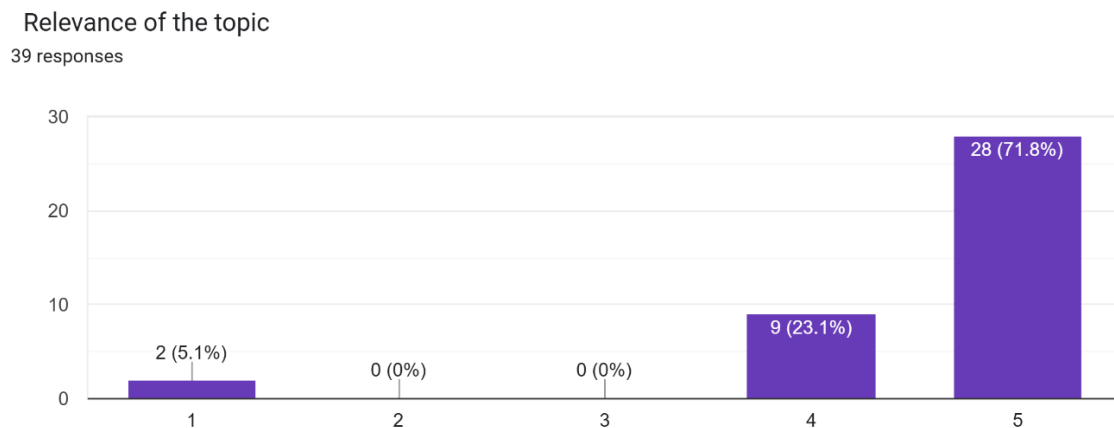

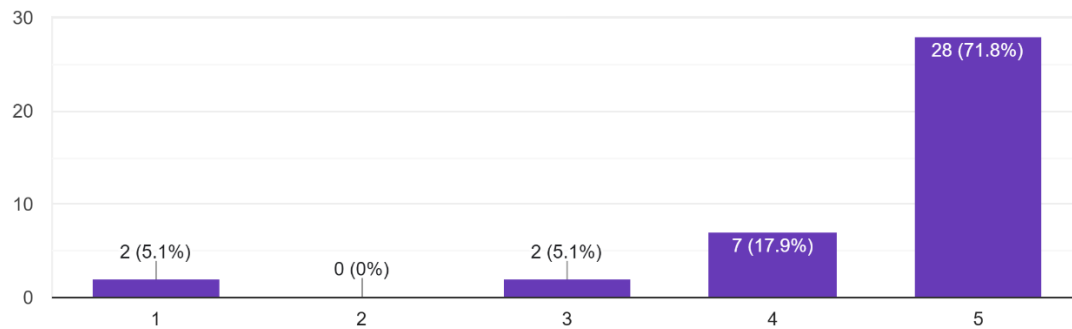

For the parameter of Relevance of Topic with respect to Speaker 1, out of 39 responses, 74.4% of the participants expressed that they were highly satisfied.

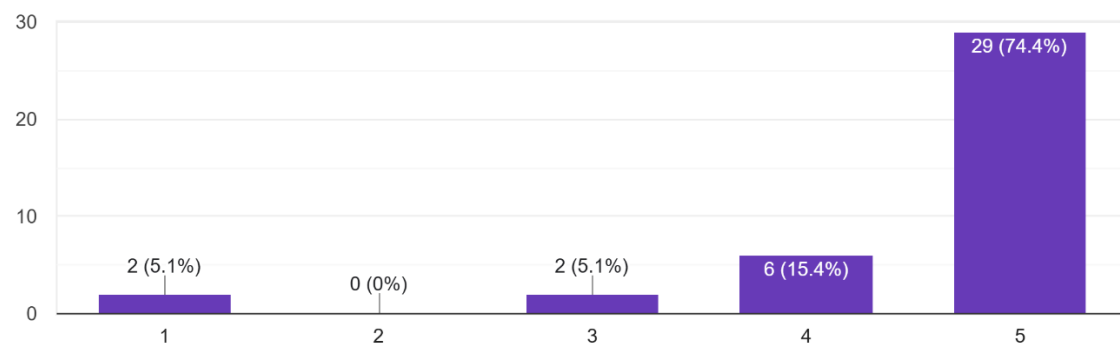
Clarity of presentation

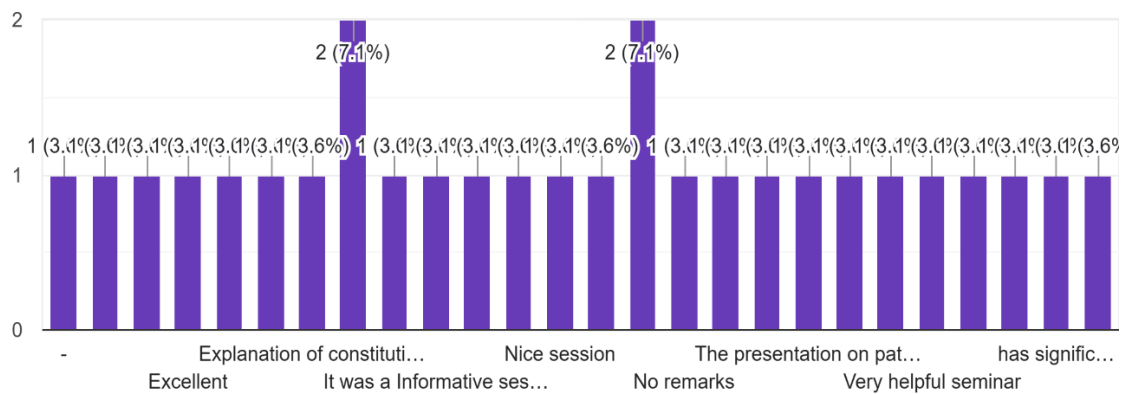

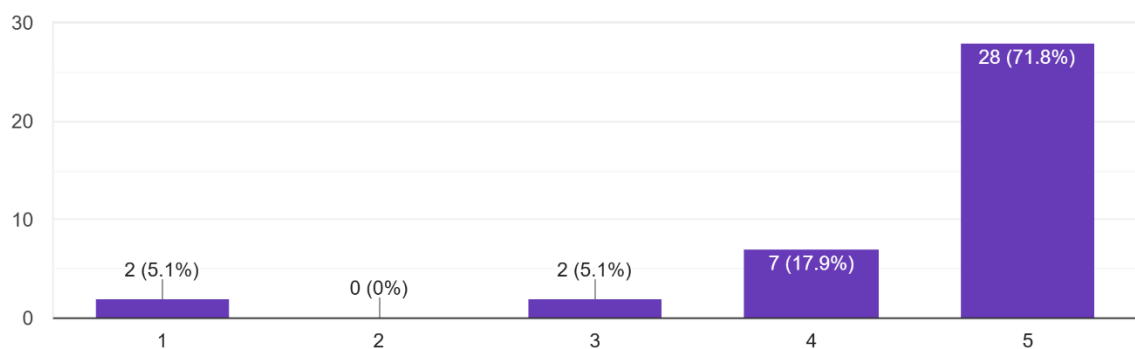

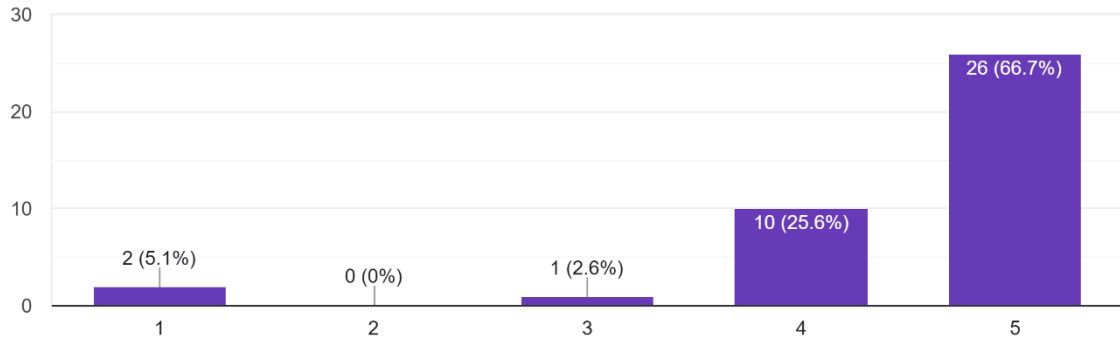

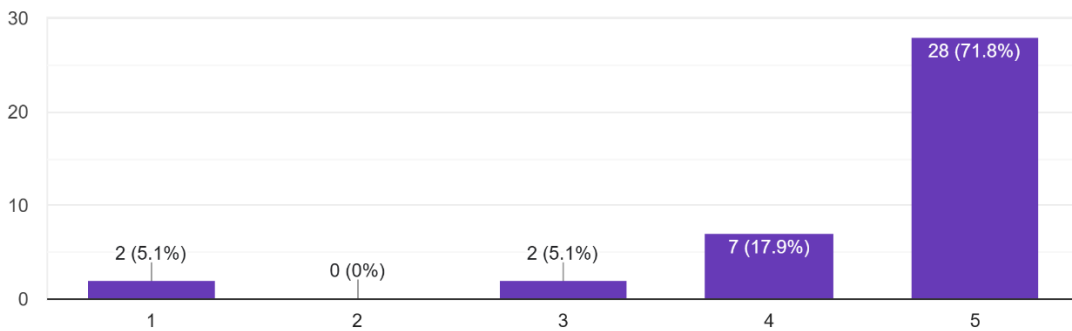

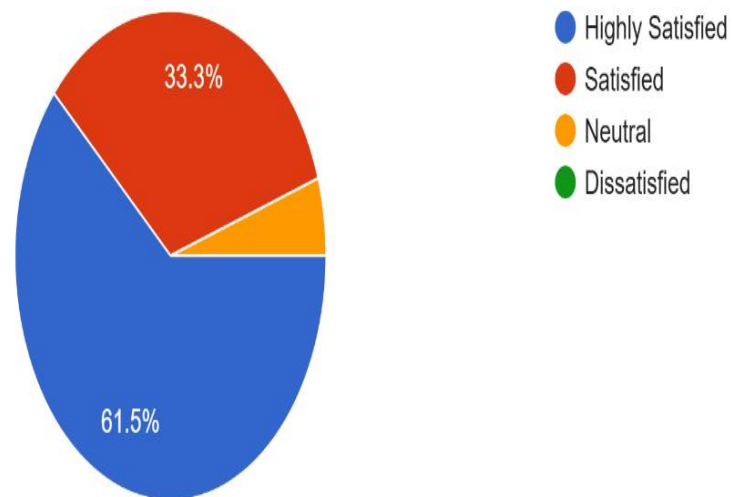

The feedback analysis regarding overall satisfaction with the program (based on 39 responses) indicates that a majority of participants were positive about the program. - A specification may be filed either as a provisional or complete specification. Provisional or Complete Specification shall be submitted in Form-2 along with the Application Form-1 and other documents accompanied with the prescribed fee.
- When the applicant finds that his invention has reached a stage where it can be disclosed but has not attained the final stage, he may prepare a disclosure of the invention in the form of a written description and submit it to Patent Office as a Provisional Specification.
- Complete Specification is a legal document which fully and particularly describes the invention and discloses the best method of performing the invention.
