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About the University

Brief Report of the Sessions

The orientation program for Ph.D. scholars at The ICFAI University Tripura aimed to welcome the new batch and provide them with essential knowledge and resources to begin their research journey. The event included a series of insightful talks, starting with a welcome address by Dr. A. Ranganath, Registrar, who emphasized the importance of research. Prof. (Dr.) Priyanshu Rana Borthakur, Dean of FST, provided an overview of the institution's legacy, while Prof. (Dr.) Dhananjoy Datta, Dean of Research & Development, explained the Ph.D. program structure and the importance of research ethics. Additional sessions covered the objectives of research by Prof. (Dr.) Subhasish Chatterjee, motivation for research by Prof. (Dr.) Prasanta Kumar Sinha, and the significance of research in the context of the National Education Policy by Prof. (Dr.) Prem Shankar Srivastava. The program concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Pritam Roy, a research scholar, IUT. Overall, the orientation successfully equipped the scholars with a clear understanding of institutional policies, research processes, and available resources, while also inspiring them to pursue impactful research and become integral contributors to the academic community.

Detail Report of the Program

- ➤ Dr. A. Ranganath, Registrar, began with a welcome address highlighting the institution's rich academic heritage and the importance of research, emphasizing the pivotal role of scholarly inquiry in academic growth, the address set the tone for an engaging and insightful interaction. His address inspired students and faculty alike, reinforcing the importance of critical thinking and continuous learning in the academic journey.
- > Dr. Aviral Kumar Tiwari, Associate Professor of Economics and the Chairperson of Research & Publications at the Indian Institute of Management Bodh Gaya (IIMBG). His academic journey is marked by excellence in economics, with research contributions spanning applied econometrics, energy economics, financial markets, and sustainable development. During the orientation, he delivered a session on "Ph.D. & Research: Paradigm Shift & Road Ahead." He highlighted how the landscape of doctoral research has been evolving due to globalization, technological integration, and interdisciplinary approaches. Dr. Tiwari emphasized the need for scholars to adopt innovative methodologies, engage with emerging research paradigms, and align their work with both academic rigor and societal needs. His talk encouraged students to approach research with critical thinking and a forward-looking mindset.
- ➤ Dr. Raveesh Krishnankutty, Assistant Professor in Finance and Accounting at the Indian Institute of Management Ranchi (IIM Ranchi). His expertise lies in financial analytics, accounting research, and the integration of modern technological tools into business research. He spoke on "Research in the Era of Artificial Intelligence (AI)." Dr. Krishnankutty stressed how AI is revolutionizing the way research is conceptualized, executed, and applied. He elaborated on the role of AI in data mining, predictive analysis, and decision-making processes, while also cautioning about ethical concerns and the need for responsible use of technology. His session offered scholars a futuristic perspective, equipping them to incorporate advanced tools into their research work effectively.
- ➤ Prof. (Dr.) Priyanshu Rana Borthakur, Dean of Faculty of Science and Technology, delivered an insightful talk on research field. He highlighted the institution's legacy, core values, and commitment to academic excellence. He highlighted the group's contributions to education, particularly its innovative pedagogy, Key Achievements, and a strong focus on research and development. Special emphasis was placed on the Group's strong commitment to research and development, which continues to drive intellectual

inquiry and academic rigor across its campuses. His address not only provided a deep insight into the ethos and aspirations of IUT but also inspired the audience to actively participate in the university's mission of nurturing future-ready professionals and lifelong learners.

- Prof (Dr.) Dhananjoy Datta, Dean of Research & Development, emphasized the knowledge on program structure and operation. He emphasized the importance of maintaining integrity in research, avoiding plagiarism, and adhering to ethical guidelines. In his address, he placed strong emphasis on the importance of upholding the highest standards of academic integrity. He spoke passionately about the need for originality in research work, the dangers and consequences of plagiarism, and the ethical responsibilities that every scholar must adhere to in the pursuit of knowledge. He also highlighted the role of ethical research practices in ensuring credibility, societal impact, and long-term academic value. His insights served as a guiding light for emerging researchers, reinforcing the idea that true scholarship is rooted not only in discovery but also in discipline, responsibility, and respect for the academic community.
- ➤ Prof. (Dr.) Subhasish Chatterjee, Dean of Academic Affairs, delivered an enlightening talk on the "Objectives of Research." His session was part of the orientation program for Ph.D. scholars and provided valuable insights into the fundamental purposes and goals of conducting research. He elaborated on the various fundamental objectives of research, including the pursuit of new knowledge, solving existing problems, developing theories, validating existing findings, and contributing to policy and practice in relevant fields. He emphasized that research is not merely an academic exercise, but a meaningful endeavour that holds the potential to bring about real-world change and innovation. He further encouraged scholars to approach research with curiosity, critical thinking, and a sense of responsibility, stressing that meaningful research begins with asking the right questions and maintaining a spirit of inquiry. His session served to inspire and motivate the scholars, urging them to view their doctoral work as a significant contribution to their discipline and to society at large.
- ➤ Prof. (Dr.) Prasanta Kumar Sinha, Principal of Faculty of Science and Technology, Dr. Sinha's address centered on the theme of motivation in research, emphasizing the vital role research plays in advancing knowledge and solving real-world problems. He emphasized that a successful researcher is driven by passion and a deep-seated curiosity. These qualities ignite innovation and enable scholars to persist even when faced with challenges or failures. He also encouraged the Ph.D. scholars to cultivate a mindset of

resilience and openness, reminding them that every challenge in the research journey is an opportunity for growth and learning. His words served as a powerful reminder that the most impactful research often stems from a genuine desire to make a difference and contribute meaningfully to one's field and society at large.

- ➤ Prof. (Dr.) Prem Shankar Srivastava, Principal, Faculty of Education, The ICFAI University Tripura, delivered an inspiring talk on the *Importance of Research with reference* to the NEP during the Orientation Program for Ph.D. Scholars. Drawing from his vast experience, he emphasized the transformative power of research in shaping societies, advancing knowledge, and addressing pressing global issues.
